With now almost 40 participating units from Nebraska and surrounding states, utilizing close to 500 performers, our circuit hopes to continue to grow its impact on the indoor arts community and provide a quality experience for our performers.

This ever-changing activity allows units to explore their creativity and compete in events throughout eastern Nebraska and Western Iowa. HWAA produces at minimum six competitive events annually. The first three events focus on development as we offer clinics to our members in addition to the competition. The remaining three events are strictly competitive, but retain a strong emphasis on the education of our performers culminating in the final event, our regional championship.

HWAA is committed to the education of its participants. Through the process of designing, learning, and perfecting their programs, these young performers and their leaders learn valuable life skills like responsibility, sportsmanship, and dedication. Many of our performing ensembles continue their season in the weeks following our championship with performances at the Winter Guard International Championships.

The critique we receive from them is invaluable but comes at a cost. Our biggest expenditures every year come from transportation and housing of these individuals.
